Hi Michelle.

We met at the Poor Farm two summers ago, and spoke briefly at your book signing at the Walker Art Center. This past year and a half I have had a grant driven gallery project, known as TuckUnder Projects, that is somewhat modeled after The Suburban.

Here is the simple challenge:

If the Vikes win today, I get to be in the Whitney Biennial, with all the trimmings.

Will you accept this challenge? A simple yes or no via email will do.

The game is at 6:00 p.m. CDT and will be nationally televised.

I hope we can briefly chat in person on your next visit to Minneapolis for the *Painter Painter* opening at the Walker.
